

Volunteer Safeguarding Training 2019



Safeguarding Training

Safeguarding Essentials Presentation (level 1)

- Short presentation providing information on the Archdiocesan safeguarding strategy, safeguarding policy, types of abuse, grooming behaviours, personal boundaries & how to respond to safeguarding concerns & disclosures.
- All Archdiocesan personnel are required to view the presentation as part of their induction/refresher training every two years.
- For clergy, religious and employees the presentation is available on LearnConnect.
- Volunteers can view the presentation at www.safeguardingaob.com.au
- After viewing the presentation, volunteers are to complete a Confirmation of Completion form & return it to their parish, ministry or service.
- The completed form is to be submitted to the People & Culture (HR) office to have the training recorded.

Applied Safeguarding Training (level 2)

- Provides a deeper understanding of key safeguarding content & the skills to identify safeguarding risks, implement safeguards for church ministries, services & activities & effectively respond to safeguarding concerns and incidents.
- Only applies to Archdiocesan personnel whose usual role regularly involves delivering ministries, services or activities with children & vulnerable adults on behalf of the Archdiocese.
- · The Safeguarding Essentials Presentation is a pre-requisite for this training.
- Those who are not confirmed as having viewed the presentation cannot register for this training.
- The training will be delivered by the Office for Safeguarding Services.

ALL Volunteers now need to ensure that they have completed Safeguarding Training. The Archdiocese of Brisbane has launched a new simpler 2019 Safeguarding Training Plan. Safeguarding Training is now structured into:

Applied Safeguarding Training - Level 2 -

Please note, the following training **ONLY** applies to personnel (clergy, employees & volunteers) who:

- provide services mainly for children/vulnerable adults;
 or
- engage in activities mainly with children/vulnerable adults.

Please note Level 1 Video needs to be viewed prior to attending Level 2 Training.
