

Parish Leadership Team: Report from December Meeting

Members of the Parish Liturgy Team joined the meeting. There were reports from Fr John (Parish) and from Janet Smith (School). There were two main items for brief discussion:

1. **Consideration of the General Meeting of 17 November.** Most reports went over time, but those 18 reports gave a clear view of the complexity, depth, and detail of the many dimensions of parish activity. This matrix of activity is bound together by volunteers, many of whom undertake many different tasks. The parish needs more volunteers, and groups need a place for publishing information about their function and activities. Future general meetings can now require more succinct reports, as there will be avenues for publicity and information on the parish website and perhaps in a resurrected annual publication of *Trinity*.
2. Planning for festivities associated with the Feast of St Dympna (15 May) will begin with a meeting on 18 February 2020. This Feast will be celebrated on Sunday 17 May, and a number of festivities are to be planned for the day. Information about the meeting will be available early in February in the parish newsletter.
